



Launch of the Czech Piloting

November 2020

As part of the a4i project, the Czech Republic, Belgium and Spain will launch a piloting based on a new cross-sectoral teaching concept, with integrated academic and adult training learning methods and case examples of good practices to provide to Social Services Providers and Private Investors common knowledge and tools. In October 2020, the Czech Republic was the first country to start its piloting, which was leading by the Association of Social Services Providers, Czech Republic (APSS CR). The Czech partners divided the a4i Professional Development Programme into three groups and organized the first one face to face in Prague. The training was attended by 14 participants and most of them were from private social service sector.

1st day

Mr. Horecky delivered detailed presentation focus on description of social service sector and their needs the role of private investors, actual capacities in nursing homes, homes for the elderly and compared it with foreign countries. He also added this presentation about actual information from bilateral meetings and negotiations between Ministry of Finance and Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs. These two authorities significantly affect the whole form of the social services sector in the Czech Republic.

2nd day

Mr. Jan Šnajdr from Česká spořitelna presented the strategy for investment needs and mitigation of investment risks and financial planning in general. He based his analysis on several examples of good and bad practices.

The Czech piloting will continue and will be followed by Belgium and Spain. Due to the Coronavirus crisis, an online piloting will certainly take place in at least one of the countries.
