



InvestEU 2021-2027

January 2021

Starting in 2021, InvestEU will replace the European Fund for Strategic Investments (EFSI), also known as the "Juncker Plan" to support **employment, growth and innovation** in Europe. In the context of the coronavirus crisis, it will also be a recovery tool to make EU economy more **sustainable and resilient** and achieve its long-term **green and digital transition**.

On [December 2020](#), a political agreement between the European Commission, Parliament and Council has been reached.

What is InvestEU for?

The InvestEU Programme will finance four policy windows:

- **Sustainable infrastructure**
- **Research, Innovation and Digitalisation**
- **SMEs**
- **Social Investment and Skills**

Thus, it will help to support new ecosystems of entrepreneurs, cross-border strategic projects and critical infrastructure as well as the development of new technologies within the EU.

What is InvestEU's budget?

The budget guarantee of 26.2 billion euros will be distributed among the four windows:

- "Sustainable Infrastructure window: **EUR 9.9 billion**
- Research, Innovation and Digitisation window: **EUR 6.6 billion**
- SME window : **EUR 6.9 billion**
- Social Investment and Skills window: **EUR 2.8 billion**"
